



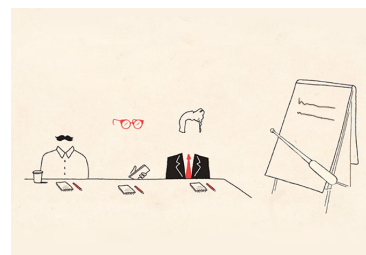

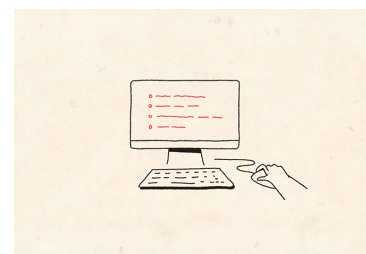
## The Gymglish approach
